

Article VIII. Grievance Committees

§ 1. Duties. The grievance committee in each state bar district shall investigate within such district all matters within the jurisdictions of the committees on legal ethics and on unlawful practice, and shall make report and recommendation thereon to the appropriate committee and to the secretary. It shall also perform such other functions and duties in its district as the board may prescribe from time to time, including, when authorized by the board, the exercise of all rights, powers and duties of every kind provided for the committees on legal ethics and on unlawful practice.

§ 2. Members. Such grievance committees shall consist of such number of members, appointed by the board for such terms, as the board may from time to time determine. Each such committee shall have a chairman, selected annually by the board.
